

Spring Hikes at Steyermark Woods Conservation Area Hannibal MO

Saturday April 20, 1:00pm-3:00pm

The Mississippi Hills Master Naturalist Chapter will host an interpretive nature hike at Steyermark Woods Conservation Area in Hannibal on Saturday, April 20. The focus will be on Spring Wildflower identification. Participants will observe and learn about the conservation area, woodland habitat, flowering trees and ephemeral wildflowers in bloom.

Plan to meet near the parking area at 1pm. Participants should wear good hiking shoes and clothing appropriate for the weather, and should consider bringing a camera, binoculars, water, and snacks.

The Mississippi Hills Master Naturalist Chapter will also host a second hike on April 20th at Steyermark Woods which will start an hour later than the wildflower hike, from 2:00pm-3:00pm, and only last an hour. Plan to meet near the parking area at 2pm. This hike will be at a faster pace and will not have the more in-depth discussions about wildflowers seen along the trail.

Directions: From Hwy 168 in Hannibal, turn right on Co Road 410. Travel east for one mile. Steyermark Woods CA will be on your right.
